AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF PARKING METERS IN THE TOWN OF NATICK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Natick may provide by
2 rule, regulation, order or by-law for the angular
3 parking of motor vehicles in connection with the use
4 of parking meters on Main street in said town, and
5 such provision shall be effective without the approval
6 of the department of public works under section two
7 of chapter eighty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.

SECTION 1. The Commission on the Administration of the Government shall be composed of the following members:

SECTION 2. The Commission shall have the honor of the rank of Major-General in the Army of the United States.

SECTION 3. The Commission shall be organized as soon as possible after its appointment.

SECTION 4. The Commission shall have the right to call upon any department or agency of the Government for such information as it may require.

SECTION 5. The Commission shall have the right to hold public hearings and to receive testimony from any person who may wish to give it.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
