The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROVIDING AN OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL AND DRESSING ROOMS IN SAXON FOSS PARK IN THE CITY OF SOMERVILLE BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission
2 is hereby authorized and directed to construct an out-
3 door swimming pool and dressing rooms on land of
4 the city of Somerville in Saxon Foss park in Somer-
5 ville, in accordance with the provisions of chapter
6 ninety-two of the General Laws. For the purposes of
7 constructing said swimming pool and dressing rooms
8 said commission may expend such sums as may here-
9 after be appropriated therefor.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act, the metro-
2 politan district commission may take in the name of
3 the commonwealth, in fee or otherwise, under chap-
4 ter seventy-nine of the General Laws, or acquire by
5 purchase, gift or otherwise, such public land in the city
6 of Somerville as may be necessary.

The Commission of Enquiry

In the Year 1890
