By Mr. Skerry of Medford, petition of Joseph P. Lenox and Michael F. Skerry for increasing the retirement allowance of said Lenox a former employe of the state highway department. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF JOSEPH P. LENOX OF MEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The retirement allowance of Joseph P. Lenox of
2 Medford, formerly an employe of the highway de-
3 partment of the commonwealth, who sustained dis-
4 abling and permanent injuries in the performance of
5 his duties is hereby increased to an amount equal to
6 one half the present rate of compensation paid to em-
7 ployees who are employed in a similar capacity as was
8 held by Joseph P. Lenox at the time of his retirement.

By Mr. Speaker, the bill (H. R. 10000) for the relief of Joseph F. Lewis, was read twice and passed.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE RELIEF OF JOSEPH F. LEWIS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the people of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. The retirement allowance of Joseph F. Lewis, formerly an employee of the highway department of the Commonwealth, who sustained disabling and permanent injuries in the performance of his duties is hereby increased to an amount equal to one half the present rate of compensation paid to one of the highest paid employees in a similar capacity as was held by Joseph F. Lewis at the time of his retirement.
