The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONTROL OF BLOOD BANKS
BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
2 trary, blood banks, exclusive of those in registered
3 hospitals, shall be under the supervision of the de-
4 partment of public health and subject to inspection
5 by district health officers. Said department of public
6 health shall establish and from time to time, amend,
7 modify, repeal or suspend rules and regulations for
8 the maintenance and operation of blood banks. If
9 any blood bank is deemed by the department of
10 public health to be operated or maintained in an
11 unsanitary manner or in violation of said rules and
12 regulations, or not properly equipped or constructed,
13 said department shall close such blood bank until
14 such time as it has been put in proper condition.

The Communitarity of Quarantines

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That

§ 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, that in the enforcement of the laws of the United States relating to the quarantine of persons and property, the following provisions shall have effect:

1. Quarantine laws shall apply to persons or property in the case of
2. any person, vessel, or property of the United States in respect

5. by the health officer of the United States, or by the health officer of any
6. health establishment, and from time to time, during
7. the period of such quarantine, and
