AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE NUMBER OF DAYS DURING WHICH HARNESS HORSE RACING MEETINGS SHALL BE ALLOWED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause (j) of subsection (5) of section 3 of chapter  
2 128A of the General Laws, as most recently amended  
3 by section 4 of chapter 575 of the acts of 1946, is  
4 hereby further amended by striking out, in line 2,  
5 the word "ninety" and inserting in place thereof the  
6 words: — one hundred and fifty, — so as to read as  
7 follows: — (j) No licenses shall be issued for more than  
8 an aggregate of one hundred and fifty racing days in  
9 any one year at the harness horse racing meetings  
10 combined, not including harness horse racing meet-  
11 ings at state or county fairs; and, except for harness  
12 horse racing meetings at state or county fairs, no  
13 license shall be issued to permit harness horse racing  
14 meetings to be held at the same time that a dog racing

15 meeting or a running horse racing meeting is being  
 16 held at a race track within ten miles of the track at  
 17 which such harness horse racing meeting is to be held;  
 18 and, except for state or county fairs, no licenses shall  
 19 be issued to permit harness horse racing meetings to  
 20 be held or conducted at the same time within twenty-  
 21 five miles of another harness horse racing meeting.
