RESOLVE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ARMORY COMMISSION TO ERECT A NEW ARMORY IN THE TOWN OF WEBSTER.

1 *Resolved*, That the armory commission be hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct in the town of
3 Webster, on land acquired or to be acquired for
4 armory purposes, a suitable and adequate armory;
5 and for said purposes may expend such sums as
6 may hereafter be appropriated therefor by the general
7 court. Sections thirty-three and thirty-four of chapter
8 thirty-three of the General Laws, as appearing in
9 section one of chapter four hundred and twenty-five
10 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-nine, shall,
11 so far as applicable, apply to proceedings taken and
12 acts done under authority of this resolve.
