AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN CLERKS AND ASSISTANT CLERKS OF COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of sec-
2 tion ninety-four of chapter two hundred twenty-one
3 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by sec-
4 tion two of chapter seven hundred seventy-four of the
5 acts of nineteen hundred and forty-nine, no clerk or
6 assistant clerk of any court shall hereafter receive
7 any lesser annual salary than he would have received
8 had said chapter seven hundred seventy-four not been
9 enacted.

1 SECTION 2. Any clerk or assistant clerk of any
2 court who, since the effective date of said chapter
3 seven hundred seventy-four, has received a lesser
4 salary than he would have received had said chapter

5 seven hundred seventy-four not been enacted, shall
 6 forthwith receive from the county by which such
 7 salary has been paid the difference between the
 8 salary which he would so have received and that which
 9 he has been paid since said effective date.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall apply
 2 only to clerks or assistant clerks in office on the effec-
 3 tive date of said chapter seven hundred seventy-four.
