By Mr. Hedges of Quincy, petition of Charles W. Hedges relative to the payment of charges for hydrant rentals to fire and water districts. Water Supply.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT TO FIRE, WATER, OR FIRE AND WATER DISTRICTS OF CHARGES FOR HYDRANT RENTALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of any
2 general or special law, every town within the territorial
3 limits of which there exists a fire, water, or fire and
4 water district shall annually pay directly to such dis-
5 trict all charges for hydrant rentals which would
6 otherwise be assessed upon and paid by individual
7 property owners, and the assessors of such city or
8 town shall increase the assessments upon all property
9 within such districts to an extent which will result in
10 an increase in the taxes upon all of such property equal
11 to the amount of such annual payment.
