AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT TO ALLAN A. GILLIS FOR MATERIALS, ALTERATIONS AND EXTRA WORK FURNISHED AND PERFORMED AT THE STATE INFIRMARY AT TEWKSBURY, MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows.*

1 That, for the purpose of discharging a moral obli-  
2 gation of the commonwealth, and after an appropria-  
3 tion has been made, there be paid from the state  
4 treasury to Allan A. Gillis as assignee of Allan A.  
5 Gillis Construction Company the sum of seventy-five  
6 thousand, two hundred and seventy-three dollars and  
7 twenty-seven cents, with interest thereon, for mate-  
8 rials, alterations and extra work furnished and per-  
9 formed by said Allan A. Gillis Construction Company  
10 in connection with the construction of three buildings  
11 at the state infirmery at Tewksbury, Massachusetts,  
12 under a contract entered into with the commonwealth  
13 dated December first, nineteen hundred and thirty-  
14 one.
