RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO PASS A FEDERAL FAIR EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES ACT.

1 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts general court, as-
2 sembled in session, petition the Congress of the United
3 States to pass legislation creating a Federal Fair Em-
4 ployment Practices Act.

5 *Resolved*, That copies of this resolution be sent
6 forthwith by the secretary of the commonwealth to
7 the President of the United States, to the presiding
8 officers of each branch of Congress and to the members
9 thereof from this commonwealth.
