

HOUSE No. 1207

By Mr. Palmer of Somerville, petition of Harold A. Palmer relative to providing for the replacement of certain motor vehicle number plates without charge. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE NUMBER PLATES WITHOUT CHARGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, if
2 any number plate supplied by the registrar of motor
3 vehicles is lost or mutilated, or if the register number
4 thereon becomes illegible during the year nineteen
5 hundred and fifty, the owner or person in control of
6 the vehicle for which said number plate was furnished
7 shall make application for a new number plate, and
8 thereupon, as soon as practicable, the registrar shall
9 make and deliver to such applicant without charge a
10 number plate of the regular design.
