### AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DESIGNATION OF A PARTICULAR INSURANCE AGENT OR BROKER BY ONE LOANING MONEY ON THE SECURITY OF REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 93 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby  
3 amended by inserting after the word "merchandise"  
4 in line 7 the following:— No person, firm, associa-  
5 tion or corporation doing business in the common-  
6 wealth, selling property, real or personal, extending  
7 credit, or making loans, shall directly or indirectly,  
8 influence the purchaser or borrower to purchase insur-  
9 ance, or the renewal of such insurance, for their joint  
10 or several protection, from a specified insurance agent  
11 or broker.
