AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMPULSORY MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law
2 no insurance company authorized to issue a motor
3 vehicle liability policy as defined in section thirty-
4 four A of chapter ninety shall refuse to issue such a
5 policy if the applicant therefor is the holder of a
6 license to operate motor vehicles under section eight
7 of chapter ninety and if a certificate of inspection
8 for the vehicle for which such application is made
9 has been issued under section seven A of said chapter.
