AN ACT ABOLISHING THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND TRANSFERRING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES TO A COMMISSION TO BE ESTABLISHED IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Metropolitan Transit Authority, created by
2 chapter 544 of the acts of 1947, is hereby abolished.
3 All its powers and duties shall be transferred to, and
4 all the assets, property and franchises heretofore ac-
5 quired and operated by it shall be vested in, a com-
6 mission to be established in the department of public
7 works, and consisting of five members to be appointed
8 by the governor with the advice and consent of the
9 council.
