AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR INCREASE IN COMPENSATION OF
THE STATE JUDGE ADVOCATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (b) of section 69 of chapter 33 of the
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in the eighth line, the words "fifteen
4 hundred" and inserting in place thereof the words: —
5 twenty-five hundred, — so as to read as follows:
6 — (b) There shall be a state judge advocate who,
7 under the direction of the adjutant general, shall be
8 the legal adviser of the military division in matters
9 referred to him by law or by the commander-in-chief.
10 He shall examine and report in writing to the com-
11 mander-in-chief on all proceedings of courts-martial
12 requiring the action of the commander-in-chief. He
13 shall bring all necessary actions, in connection with
14 the foregoing, and, except when ordered on duty
15 under sections eleven, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen
16 or one hundred and five, shall receive a salary of
17 twenty-five hundred dollars.
