AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PLACING OF THE OFFICE OF
MANAGER OF THE BOARD OF ASSESSORS OF THE CITY
OF MALDEN UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The position of office manager of the
2 board of assessors of the city of Malden shall, upon
3 the effective date of this act, become subject to the
4 civil service laws and regulations made thereunder,
5 and the term of office of any incumbent thereof shall
6 be unlimited subject however to said laws but the
7 person holding said office on said effective date shall
8 continue to serve therein only until the expiration of
9 his term of office unless prior thereto he passes a non-
10 competitive qualifying examination to which he shall
11 be subjected by the division of civil service.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance, during the current year, by vote of the
3 city council of the city of Malden, subject to the
4 provisions of its charter but not otherwise.

The bill is hereby introduced in the House of Representatives of the State of Massachusetts, and is referred to the Committee on the Administration of the Government, and the bill is ordered to be printed.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE OF OFFICE AND COMPENSATION OF THE CHIEF INVESTIGATOR OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONTROL COMMISSION.

1 The present chief investigator of the alcoholic
2 beverages control commission shall hold office con-
3 tinuously during good behavior unless incapacitated
4 by mental or physical disability; provided, however,
5 that said commission, subject to the provisions of
6 law governing the removal of civil service employees,
7 remove him. The salary of said chief investigator
8 shall be the maximum amount in Salary Grade No. 54
9 in the general salary schedule under section forty-six
10 of chapter thirty of the General Laws.
