AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CIVIL SERVICE PROTECTION FOR
EMPLOYEES IN THE INSTITUTIONS, HOSPITALS, SCHOOLS
AND COLLEGES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 On and after the effective date of this act all po-
- 2 sitions, appointments and promotions in the in-
- 3 stitutions, hospitals, schools and colleges of the
- 4 commonwealth shall be subject to the provisions of
- 5 chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.
- 6 Every person holding office or employment in the
- 7 institutions, hospitals, schools and colleges of the
- 8 commonwealth on the effective date of this act shall
- 9 have unlimited tenure of office or employment, sub-
- 10 ject to the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the
- 11 General Laws and the rules made thereunder, and
- 12 shall have all the rights and privileges provided therein
- 13 without further examinations.
