### AN ACT REGULATING THE RATE OF CONTRIBUTIONS PAYABLE BY EMPLOYERS SUBJECT TO THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section 14 and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following:—

4 *Section 14.* Each employer shall make contribu-  
5 tions for the year nineteen hundred and fifty-one and  
6 for each year thereafter at the rate of two and seven-  
7 tenths per cent of that portion of his pay roll as is  
8 subject to this chapter. Such portion of such pay roll  
9 shall include that part of remuneration paid or pay-  
10 able by him to an individual not in excess of three  
11 thousand dollars with respect to employment during  
12 any calendar year.
