

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A FOOTBRIDGE OVER CERTAIN TIDE WATER IN THE TOWN OF WESTPORT.

Chap. 141

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Adelard Giason, and his heirs and assigns, may erect and maintain a bridge, without a draw, connecting Goat or Great Island in the Westport river with the main land in the town of Westport, subject to the provisions of chapter ninety-one of the General Laws.

Construction and maintenance of a foot-bridge over certain tide water in town of Westport.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MOTOR VEHICLES OR TRAILERS OWNED BY NON-RESIDENTS.

Chap. 142

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter ninety of the General Laws, as most recently amended in the paragraph defining "Non-resident" by chapter one hundred and eighty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-four, is hereby further amended by striking out said paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:—

"Non-resident", any person whose legal residence is not within the commonwealth.

"Non-resident", definition.

SECTION 2. Said chapter ninety, as amended in section three by section one of chapter four hundred and thirty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby further amended by striking out said section three and inserting in place thereof the following:—*Section 3.* Subject to the provisions of section three A and except as otherwise provided in section ten, a motor vehicle or trailer registered in any other state or country and owned by a non-resident who has complied with the laws relative to motor vehicles and trailers, and the operation thereof, of the state or country of registration may be operated on the ways of this commonwealth without registration under this chapter, to the extent, as to length of time of operation and otherwise, that, as finally determined by the registrar, the state or country of registration grants substantially similar privileges in the case of motor vehicles and trailers duly registered under the laws and owned by residents of this commonwealth; provided, that no motor vehicle or trailer owned by a non-resident shall be so operated beyond the expiration of a period of thirty days except during such time as the owner thereof maintains in full force a policy of liability insurance providing indemnity for or protection to him, and to any person responsible for the operation of such motor vehicle or trailer with his express or implied consent, against loss by reason of the liability to pay damages to others for bodily injuries, including death at any time re-
