RESOLVE INSTRUCTING THE TRUSTEES OF THE SOLDIERS' HOME TO FURNISH MEDICAL AND SURGICAL CARE TO CERTAIN FEMALE VETERANS.

1 *Resolved*, That the trustees of the Soldiers' Home be  
2 instructed to furnish medical and surgical care to those  
3 female veterans who are in receipt of a discharge other  
4 than dishonorable from the service of the United  
5 States in any branch of military or naval forces be-  
6 tween the dates of April sixth, nineteen hundred and  
7 seventeen to November eleventh, nineteen hundred  
8 and eighteen, or December seventh, nineteen hundred  
9 and forty-one to December thirty-first, nineteen hun-  
10 dred and forty-six; said female veterans must have  
11 enlisted from this commonwealth or be presently  
12 domiciled therein.
