AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE WEST ROXBURY DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 78 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence,
3 inserted by chapter 710 of the acts of 1949, the fol-
4 lowing sentence:—The salary of the justice of the
5 municipal court of the West Roxbury district shall
6 be eight thousand dollars.,—and by striking out,
7 in lines 12 and 13, as appearing in section 3 of chap-
8 ter 667 of the acts of 1948, the words “municipal
9 court of the West Roxbury district,”.
