AN ACT REQUIRING ALL PATIENTS ADMITTED TO GENERAL HOSPITALS IN THE COMMONWEALTH TO BE EXAMINED FOR THE DETECTION OF TUBERCULOSIS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 All patients admitted to a general hospital in the
- 2 commonwealth, exclusive of a veterans facility, shall
- 3 be examined by X-ray for the detection of tuberculosis.
