RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO A FATHER'S LIABILITY, IN ADOPTION PROCEEDINGS, TO SUPPORT HIS MINOR CHILDREN.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to
2 investigate the subject matter of current house docu-
3 ment numbered two hundred and twenty, relative to
4 a father's liability, in adoption proceedings, to support
5 his minor children, and to include its conclusions and
6 its recommendations, if any, in relation thereto, to-
7 gether with drafts of such legislation as may be neces-
8 sary to give effect to the same, in its annual report
9 for the year nineteen hundred and fifty.
