By Messrs. Karelitz of Haverhill and Pothier of Haverhill, petition of Clarence Karelitz, Harvey A. Pothier and John W. Coddair, Jr., that provision be made for the creation of a development and industrial commission for the city of Haverhill. Cities.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF A DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF HAVERHILL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of
2 any general or special law to the contrary, the city of
3 Haverhill may appropriate for a period of two years,
4 commencing in the current year, a sum not exceeding
5 ten thousand dollars for the purpose of creating a
6 development and industrial commission for the promo-
7 tion and development of the industrial resources of
8 said city. The commission shall conduct researches
9 into industrial conditions and shall seek to co-ordinate
10 the activities of unofficial bodies organized for said
11 purposes, and may advertise, prepare, print and
12 distribute books, maps, charts and pamphlets which
13 in its judgment will further the purposes for which
14 it is created. In carrying out the provisions of this

15 act the commission may appoint such experts, clerks
16 and employees as it may require; provided, that
17 said appointees shall not be subject to the provisions
18 of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws. Members
19 of the commission or its authorized agents may travel
20 within or without the commonwealth for the purpose
21 of carrying out the provisions of this act. Appoint-
22 ments and money expended hereunder shall be under
23 the direction of the mayor and aldermen in accordance
24 with its charter.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
