RESOLUTIONS WELCOMING VISITORS FROM OTHER STATES TO THE GREATER BOSTON FEIS AND CONGRATULATING THE PERSONS AND ORGANIZATIONS PARTICIPATING IN PRESENTING THE SAME.

1 *Whereas*, The Greater Boston Feis, patterned after
2 the Feis Temhur which has been held annually in
3 Ireland since Druidic times, and which is the out-
4 standing artistic, mental and athletic festival in the
5 world, with competitions in poetry, literature, history,
6 story telling, instrumental music, singing, elocution
7 and dancing, as well as weight throwing, Gaelic foot-
8 ball and hurling, will be held July thirtieth, nineteen
9 hundred and fifty, in Malden Municipal Stadium;

11 *Whereas*, Nearly fifteen hundred persons from all
12 sections of New England and New York have signi-
13 fied their intention of competing in the various events
14 at the said Greater Boston Feis; therefore be it

15 *Resolved*, That the general court extends a cordial

18 Boston Feis; and be it further
