AN ACT DIRECTING THE BOSTON HOUSING AUTHORITY TO CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS TO POLICE THE PROPERTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 7 of chapter 121B of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in section 1 of chapter 751 of the acts of 1969, is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following sentence: — So far as practicable,  
5 a housing or redevelopment authority shall make use of the  
6 services of the agencies, officers and employees of the city or  
7 town in which such authority is organized, and such city or  
8 town shall, if requested, make available such services, except,  
9 that in the city of Boston, the housing authority shall con-  
10 tract with said city for the assignment of one hundred police  
11 officers of the police department of said city to police the  
12 buildings and grounds owned by said authority with the pro-  
13 viso that said authority shall reimburse said city for one third  
14 of the cost thereof.

For the 10 years of which the present law is in force, the law is applicable to the French Republic and to the States which have been admitted to the Congress of 1857, and to the States which have been admitted to the Congress of 1860.
