RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO DIRECTING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO PERSONS OVER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE WHO DO NOT POSSESS LICENSES TO OPERATE MOTOR VEHICLES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-
2 bers of the Senate, two members of the House of Representa-
3 tives, the registrar of motor vehicles, the commissioner of
4 public safety, and three persons appointed by the governor, is
5 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
6 and study relative to the advisability of directing the registrar
7 of motor vehicles to issue identification cards to persons over
8 twenty-one years of age who do not possess licenses to op-
9 erate motor vehicles.
