

SENATE No. 178

By Mr. McIntyre, a petition of James R. McIntyre for legislation to provide that a certain physical condition or disease resulting in total or partial disability or death to fire and police signal maintenance repairmen, who are full time paid employees of the cities and towns of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, working on municipally owned fire and police signal systems, shall be presumed to have been suffered in the line of duty with reference to the accidental disability retirement law. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A CERTAIN PHYSICAL CONDITION OR DISEASE RESULTING IN TOTAL OR PARTIAL DISABILITY OR DEATH TO FIRE AND POLICE SIGNAL MAINTENANCE REPAIRMEN, WHO ARE FULL TIME PAID EMPLOYEES OF THE CITIES AND TOWNS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, WORKING ON MUNICIPALLY OWNED FIRE AND POLICE SIGNAL SYSTEMS, SHALL BE PRESUMED TO HAVE BEEN SUFFERED IN THE LINE OF DUTY WITH REFERENCE TO THE ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 94 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in chapter 610 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by in-
- 3 serting in line 16, after the word "Airport" the words: — "or
- 4 to a fire and police signal maintenance repairman who is a full
- 5 time paid employee of a City or Town of the Commonwealth."
