AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES IN GROUP 4 OF THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The definition of *Group 2* in paragraph (g) of
2 subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws,
3 as appearing in section 1 of chapter 650 of the acts of 1968,
4 is hereby amended by striking out the words "district fire
5 wardens".

1 SECTION 2. The definition of *Group 4* in paragraph (g) of
2 subdivision (2) of section 3 of said chapter 32, as so appear-
3 ing is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Guard",
4 in line 8, the words:—, employees of the department of natural
5 resources who hold the position of conservation helper, skilled
6 conservation helper, forest fire patrolman and district fire-
7 warden, .
