AN ACT FURTHER AMENDING THE SUNDAY BLUE LAWS TO ALLOW FOR THE OBSERVATION IN STORES OF FURNITURE AND HOUSEHOLD ITEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 136, section 6 of the General Laws be amended by
2 adding clause 47 so as to read:

3 *Clause 47.* The opening of a store primarily engaged in the
4 retail sale of furniture and household items for the purpose of
5 allowing the general public to observe and examine such furni-
6 ture and household items, but in no manner to enter into or
7 consummate a sale of such furniture and household items on
8 said day.
