AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SECURITY IN PROBATE COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 adding after section thirty-two A, as amended by chapter 229,  
3 section one of the acts of 1952, the following section:  
4 *Section 32B.* The judges of probate for Norfolk County may  
5 appoint three messengers for the court of probate and insolv-  
6 ency for said county, may remove them at their pleasure, and  
7 may fill vacancies caused by removal and otherwise. Said mes-  
8 sengers shall wait upon said court and perform such duties  
9 as the judges may direct, including duty as court officers of  
10 said court. They shall, while in attendance on said court, wear  
11 uniforms, such as the court shall order, to be furnished at the  
12 expense of said county. Each such messenger shall receive in  
13 full for all services performed by him such salary as shall be  
14 fixed by the judge of said court, to be paid by said county.
