AN ACT REQUIRING THE SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE BUREAU OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO APPROVE PLANS SUBMITTED TO IT WITHIN SIXTY DAYS, OR TO STATE IN WRITING THE REASONS FOR REJECTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Application to the School Building Assistance Bureau for
- 2 reimbursement of school construction costs which are submit-
- 3 ted pursuant to Acts of 1948, Chapter 645 shall be processed
- 4 within sixty days and approval in writing issued prior to the
- 5 sixty-first day after submission. If approval is not granted,
- 6 written notification within the sixty-one days shall be issued
- 7 stating specifically the reasons for rejection.
