The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT TEACHERS IN THE INSTITUTIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH BE GIVEN SALARY CREDIT FOR DEGREES HELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of the law to the contrary,  
2 the director of personnel and standardization shall advance  
3 teachers, head teachers, and principals of institutions of the  
4 Commonwealth as follows: —

5 (a) All teachers presently in job group classification 12 to  
6 be placed in job group classification 15.

7 (b) All teachers who have an earned Master's degree and  
8 now in job group classification 12 to be placed in job  
9 group classification 16.

10 (c) Head teachers shall be placed in a single higher job  
11 classification at his appropriate degree level.

12 (d) Principals shall be placed in the second higher job group  
13 classification at his appropriate level.
