AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NASHOBA BROOK STATE RESERVATION IN THE TOWNS OF LITTLETON, ACTON AND WESTFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established the Nashoba Brook
2 State Reservation within the area bounded by route 2A, route
3 110, route 225 and route 27.

1 SECTION 2. The department of natural resources is hereby
2 authorized to acquire such lands as may be necessary by gift,
3 purchase or eminent domain, and to expend therefor such
4 sums, not exceeding three million dollars, as may be appropri-
5 ated.
