AN ACT PERMITTING HUNTING ON SUNDAYS DURING
HUNTING SEASON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The second sentence of section 57 of chapter
2 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter
3 802 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by inserting after
4 the words "on Sunday", in line 2, the following:—

5 except between one o'clock post meridian and sunset during
6 the period commencing with the second Sunday of December
7 and ending with the beginning of the closed season.

1 SECTION 2. Section 6 of chapter 136 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end the following:—

3 (47). The hunting of birds and mammals as provided in
4 section fifty-seven of chapter one hundred and thirty-one not
5 otherwise prohibited by law.
