AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH TO GRANT AN EASEMENT OVER, UNDER AND ACROSS CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF NATICK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any other provision of the General Laws,
2 the department of natural resources, by act of its commis-
3 sioner, is hereby authorized and directed to grant to Carling
4 Brewing Company Incorporated, a corporation organized un-
5 der the laws of the State of Virginia, with a principal place
6 of business within the commonwealth of Massachusetts in Na-
7 tick, Middlesex County, its successors and assigns, the right
8 and easement to construct, lay, maintain, repair and replace
9 a pipeline across and under certain lands of the commonwealth
10 adjacent to Lake Cochituate in said Natick and over the lake-
11 bed of said Lake Cochituate, said pipeline extending from
12 land of Carling Brewing Company Incorporated located on the
13 easterly side of said Lake Cochituate, more fully described as
14 Lot 2 in Certificate of Title No. 87951, filed with the Mid-
15 dlesex South Registry District in Registration Book 570, Page
16 1, to land of said Carling Brewing Company Incorporated lo-
17 cated on the westerly side of Lake Cochituate and shown as
18 Lot 1 in said Certificate of Title. Said easement shall be a
19 twenty-foot wide easement extending ten feet on both sides of
20 the center line of the pipe to be laid.
