By Mr. DiCarlo, a petition of Robert F. Donovan and Joseph J. C. DiCarlo for legislation to provide a fifteen percent additional salary for state institutional employees performing duty between certain hours. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING A FIFTEEN PERCENT ADDITIONAL SALARY FOR STATE INSTITUTIONAL EMPLOYEES PERFORMING DUTY BETWEEN CERTAIN HOURS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
- 2 law to the contrary, members of the State Institutional Service
- 3 all or substantially all of whose duties are performed between
- 4 three o'clock postmeridian and seven o'clock antemeridian or
- 5 between three o'clock postmeridian on Friday and seven o'clock
- 6 antemeridian on Monday shall receive an additional fifteen
- 7 percent in salary.
