The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH SERVICES BE CLASSIFIED IN GROUP 2 UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out of the
3 definition of Group 2, as most recently amended by chapter
4 650 of the acts of 1968, and inserting in place thereof the
5 following definition: —

6 *Group 2.* — Members of the division of state police ap-
7 pointed under the provisions of section six of chapter twenty-
8 two, members of the police force of the metropolitan district
9 commission, capitol police, public works building police, per-
10 manent water-shed guards and permanent park police, em-
11 ployees of the Massachusetts Port Authority comprising
12 guards, guard sergeants, head guard and chief of waterfront
13 police, conservation officers paid as such, district fire wardens,
14 coastal wardens in the department of natural resources, of-
15 ficials and employees of the registry of motor vehicles having
16 police powers, officials and employees of the department of
17 public safety having police powers, employees of a municipal
18 gas or electric plant who are employed as linemen, electric
19 switchboard operators, electric maintenance men, steam en-
20 gineers, boiler operators, firemen, oilers, mechanical mainte-
21 nance men and supervisors of said employees, employees of

22 the Massachusetts Port Authority at the General Edward
 23 Lawrence Logan International Airport, comprising permanent
 24 crash crewmen, fire control man, assistant fire control men,
 25 and employees of any county, regardless of any official classi-
 26 fication, whose regular and major duties require them to have
 27 the care, custody, instruction or other supervision of prison-
 28 ers, and employees of the commonwealth or of any county
 29 whose regular and major duties require them to have the care,
 30 custody, instruction or other supervision of parolees or per-
 31 sons who are mentally ill or mentally defective or of de-
 32 fective delinquents or wayward children; provided that no
 33 member who attains age sixty-five while classified in Group 1
 34 may thereafter be classified in Group 2, irrespective of change
 35 of employment.
