By Mr. Quinlan, a petition of John M. Quinlan and another for legislation to establish age sixty as the mandatory retirement age for Group 4 under the retirement laws of the Commonwealth. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AGE SIXTY AS THE MANDATORY RETIREMENT AGE FOR GROUP 4 UNDER THE RETIREMENT LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section one of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws is
- 2 hereby amended by striking out in said section the definition
- 3 of "Maximum Age" and substituting therefor the following
- 4 new definition: —
- 5 "Maximum Age", the age on the last day of the month in
- 6 which any member classified in *Group 1* as provided for in
- 7 paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section three attains age
- 8 seventy, or if classified in *Group 2* attains age sixty-five, or if
- 9 classified in *Group 3* attains age fifty-five, or if classified in
- 10 *Group 4* attains age sixty.
