## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE EXEMPTION FROM REAL ESTATE TAXES OF PUBLIC HOUSING UNITS AND THE ASSUMPTION OF SAID TAXES BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND THE UNITED STATES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of Chapter One Hundred Twenty-one B,  
2 Section Sixteen is hereby amended so as to delete the period  
3 at the end thereof and to insert the following:—  
4 ; and provided further that the difference between any sums  
5 to be thus paid in lieu of taxes and the amount that would be  
6 levied if the said property were subject to taxation shall be  
7 paid by the Commonwealth for the period of its mortgage re-  
8 sponsibility, except that, and to the extent permitted by the  
9 United States, such sum shall be levied against the United  
10 States and not against the Commonwealth for the period of  
11 any applicable mortgage responsibility of the United States.
