
By Mr. McKenna, a petition of Denis L. McKenna for legislation to authorize and direct the Department of Public Works to reduce a vertical steep grade on Route 20 in the towns of Sudbury and Wayland. Transportation.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO REDUCE A VERTICAL STEEP GRADE ON ROUTE 20, IN THE TOWNS OF SUDBURY AND WAYLAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Department of Public Works, hereinafter
2 called the Department, is hereby authorized and directed to
3 expend a sum not to exceed Dollars,
4 for the reduction of the vertical steep grade from approximate
5 Station 136 to approximate Station 166 on Route 20, known
6 as the Boston Post Road in the Towns of Sudbury and Way-
7 land, in the County of Middlesex, in order to eliminate haz-
8 ardous driving conditions.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law,
2 plans, specifications and contracts necessary to perform the
3 work authorized by this act, shall not be subject to the ap-
4 proval, control or jurisdiction of the executive office for ad-
5 ministration and finance.

1 SECTION 3. The Department may on behalf of the Common-
2 wealth make application for and use such federal funds or
3 assistance or both as it may obtain for the planning or con-
4 struction of the said project or any part thereof.
