RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC AUTHORITY TO ALLEVIATE THE PROBLEM OF SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND ALL RELATED MATTERS RELATIVE THERETO.

2 chapter sixty-five of the resolves of nineteen hundred and
3 sixty-five and most recently revived and continued by chapter
4 one of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-one shall
5 in the course of its investigation and study consider the sub-
6 ject matter of current senate document numbered 762, relative
7 to promoting and assisting in the establishment of a regional
8 approach to solid waste disposal.
