The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PLYMOUTH COUNTY TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE ALTERATION, RENOVATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONS, INCLUDING FURNISHING AND EQUIPPING, TO THE PLYMOUTH COURT HOUSE AND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' BUILDING, FORMING A CONNECTING LINK BETWEEN SAID BUILDINGS, IN THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Plymouth county
2 are hereby authorized to make alterations, renovations and
3 construction of additions, including furnishing and equipping,
4 to the Plymouth court house and county commissioners' build-
5 ing, forming a connecting link between said buildings, in the
6 town of Plymouth. Said commissioners may expend for the
7 purposes of this act such sums as may be necessary not ex-
8 ceeding in the aggregate seven hundred and fifty thousand
9 dollars, which sum may include monies previously appropriated
10 and presently reserved under line 6 of item 18 of section one
11 of chapter six hundred and forty-six of the acts of nineteen
12 hundred and seventy. Any funds received from the federal
13 government for the purposes of this act shall be included in
14 as part of the total amount authorized for expenditures here-
15 under.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes authorized by section one, the
2 treasurer of said county, with the approval of the county
3 commissioners, may borrow upon the credit of the county such
4 sums as may be necessary not exceeding in the aggregate five

5 hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars and may issue
6 bonds or notes of the county thereof which shall bear on their
7 face the words, Plymouth County Court House Loan, Act of
8 1971. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan
9 and such loans shall be payable not more than ten years from
10 their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county
11 treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the county com-
12 missioners. The county may sell the said securities at public
13 or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county
14 commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their
15 par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as
16 herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the Gen-
17 eral Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
