AN ACT REQUIRING LICENSED PREMISES TO DISPLAY A SIGN THAT ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE INJURIOUS TO HEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 15A the following section:—

3 *Section 15B.* Any person holding a license under section twelve  
4 or fifteen shall display prominently on the licensed premises a sign  
5 advising that the consumption of alcoholic beverages may be  
6 injurious to health.
