AN ACT DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF THE COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS IN RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES, PENSIONS AND ANNUITIES OF RETIRED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AND CERTAIN BENEFICIARIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subject to the provisions of section one hundred and two of  
2 Chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as most recently amended  
3 by Chapter one hundred and ninety-one of the Acts of nineteen  
4 hundred and eighty-two, the retirement allowance, pension or  
5 annuity of every former employee of the Commonwealth or of any  
6 county, city, town, district, housing or redevelopment authority, or  
7 the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority or of the Massachusetts  
8 Port Authority, or of the spouse or other beneficiary of any such  
9 employee who is receiving a retirement allowance, pension, or  
10 annuity shall, beginning July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-  
11 three be increased by six per cent.
