AN ACT DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL SERVICE TO FORWARD ANNUALLY IN THE MONTH OF MAY TO EVERY PUBLIC AND PAROCHIAL HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COMMONWEALTH A LIST OF JOB OPENINGS IN THE STATE AGENCIES AND A COMPREHENSIVE LIST OF ALL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS TO BE HELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The director of civil service is hereby authorized and directed to
- 2 forward annually in the month of May to every public and paroch-
- 3 ial high school in the commonwealth a list of all job openings in the
- 4 state agencies and a comprehensive list of all civil service examina-
- 5 tions to be held.

1. All the members of the House shall be elected for two years, and shall be eligible for re-election.

ARTICLE II

Section 1. The House shall consist of members chosen every second year by the people of the several States.

2. The electors in each State shall have the qualifications for electors in the most numerous branch of the State Government.

3. The House shall have the sole Power of Impeachment.

4. The House shall choose its Speaker and other Officers, and shall determine the Rules of its Proceedings.
