## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT SALES OF GUIDE DOGS AND THE SERVICES AND SUPPLIES NEEDED TO MAINTAIN THE SAME SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE SALES TAX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:*

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 169B of chapter 514 of the acts of 1978, is
- 3 hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 (ee) sale of guide dogs, and the food, medicine, equipment and
- 5 supplies used in the proper care and maintenance of a guide dog,
- 6 providing that the guide dog's owner presents a valid guide dog
- 7 school's photo-identification card at time of purchase.
