### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE APPOINTMENT OF PROBATION OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 83 of Chapter 276 of the General Laws is hereby amend-  
2 ed by deleting on lines 22 and 23, the phrase: — “other than the  
3 Municipal Court of the City of Boston” and further amended by  
4 deleting the sentence beginning with the word “In” on line 31 and  
5 ending with the word “officer” on line 36, and in its place substitut-  
6 ing the following sentence: — “In the Municipal Court of the City  
7 of Boston those probation officers now designated as second assist-  
8 ant chief and deputy probation officers shall be designated as  
9 assistant chief probation officers on the effective date of this act.”
