AN ACT PROVIDING THE TOWN OF WESTPORT WITH A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF MONEY FOR ADDITIONAL POLICE AT THE HORSENECK BEACH RESERVATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, and subject to  
2 appropriation therefor the town of Westport shall be reimbursed  
3 annually an amount equal to two per cent of the revenue collected  
4 from parking, camping and season pass fees at Horseneck Beach  
5 Reservation. Such returned funds shall be used by the said town to  
6 provide additional police for the reservation, and for cleaning litter  
7 and refuse from the grounds.
