AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT AS CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS OR DEPARTMENT HEADS MAY BE INTERVIEWED BY THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY IN EXECUTIVE SESSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The fourth paragraph of Section 23B of chapter 39 of the Gener-
2 al Laws, as amended by Chapter 372 of the Acts of 1978, is hereby
3 further amended by adding after clause (7) the following clause
4 numbered (8):—

5 (8) To interview candidates for positions as chief administrative
